THE ANNULAR SOLAR ECLIPSE IS HERE TODAY. This is not to be confused with a total eclipse. An annular solar eclipse happens when the Moon covers the Sun's center, leaving the Sun's visible outer edges to form a “ring of fire” or annulus around the Moon. The bad news is we are not directly under the path, but we may see the effect. It started at 9:11 a.m., peaks 10:26 a.m., concludes 11:46 a.m. The church is located where we will see a 68.99% coverage of the sun. If the lack of cloud cover permits, use proper eye protection for looking/photographing the sun. Scan the QR code for details.

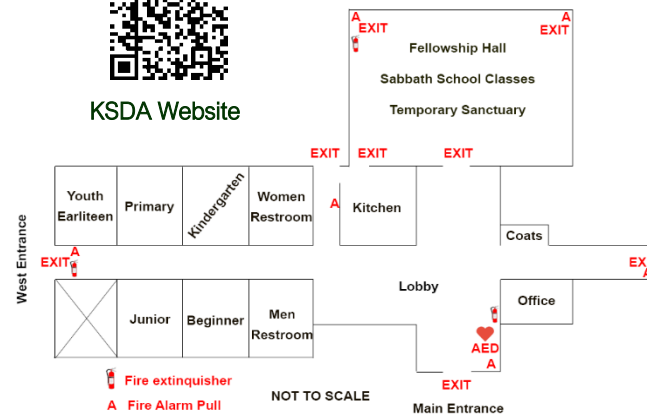
