THE KSDA CHURCH MET IN BUSINESS SESSION on Saturday night, November 18, 6:00 p.m. After much discussion, the church membership voted to ask the building committee to proceed with exploring possible designs and costs for a multi-purpose building that would not only accommodate the needs of Adventurers and Pathfinders but would also include a larger space to accommodate gym night type activities.

DECEMBER CHRISTMAS CARE & SHARE MISSION PROJECT will be supporting two different local community programs with needs.

- 1 The Evergreen School is our yearly holiday tradition and continues for those students/families with needs.
- 2 The Flathead Warming Center This local facility is for those experiencing homelessness. The Center, which opened this year on October 10, started in a rented, twenty bed maximum, building. They have since purchased and remodeled their building on Meridian to hold a maximum of fifty individuals per night. Their dormitory style bunkroom also has showers and laundry facilities available. Last winter they served 205 individuals, with 364 needing to be turned away. The nightly line up begins at 6:00 p.m. Their strict rules require them to deny stays to some. We will give different information about this community supported program weekly. Any donations to this program will go into their General Fund, with the monies distributed to different areas of need, such as, but not limited to: expansion and development, van needed for transportation, funds for daily use of local transportation for clients to go to appointments, Grab & Go food bags, and gift certificates for Thrift Stores so they can purchase clothing that fits them. These are just some of the needs.

FOURTH QUARTER OCTOBER-NOVEMBER MISSION PROJECT: is for Mt Ellis Academy's "trade school" department. This concept has been popular and needs even more support.


