CHURCH BUSINESS MEETING THIS Tuesday, December 5, 6:30 p.m. here in Fellowship Hall. The agenda is the KSDA 2024 Church Budget, voting on some administrative updates to our membership records, and we will also be sharing the direction we are being led as our congregation continues to grow.

DECEMBER CHRISTMAS CARE & SHARE MISSION PROJECT will be supporting two different local community programs with needs.

1 – The Evergreen School is our yearly holiday tradition and continues for those students/families with needs.

2 – The Flathead Warming Center – This local facility is for those experiencing homelessness. The Center, which opened this year on October 10, started in a rented, twenty bed maximum, building. They have since purchased and remodeled their building on Meridian to hold a maximum of fifty individuals per night. Their dormitory style bunkroom also has showers and laundry facilities available. Last winter they served 205 individuals, with 364 needing to be turned away. Meals for fifty nightly meals are coordinated by a volunteer and are supplied by local churches and organizations.

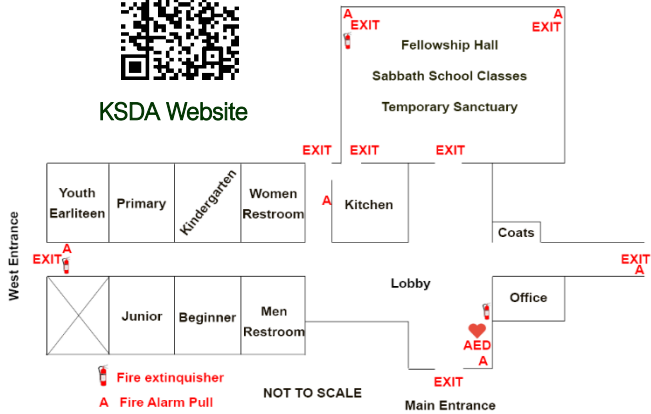
