COMMUNION is scheduled for Sabbath, January 20.

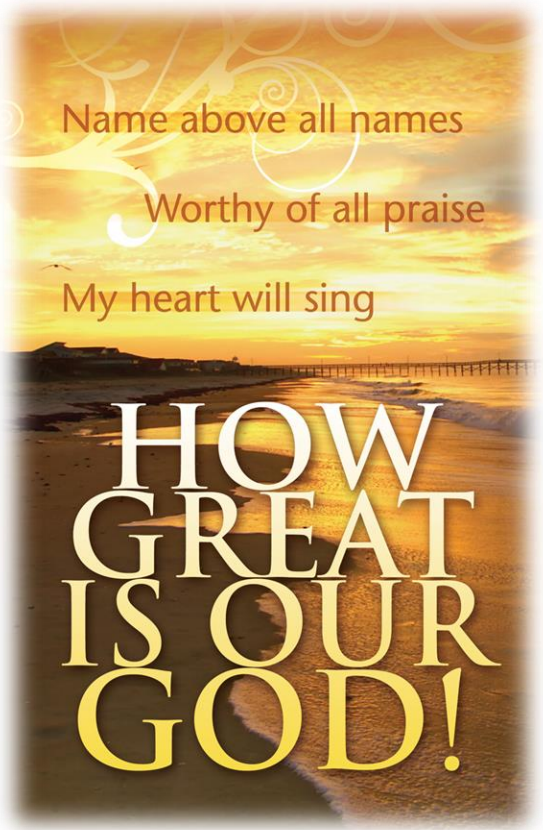

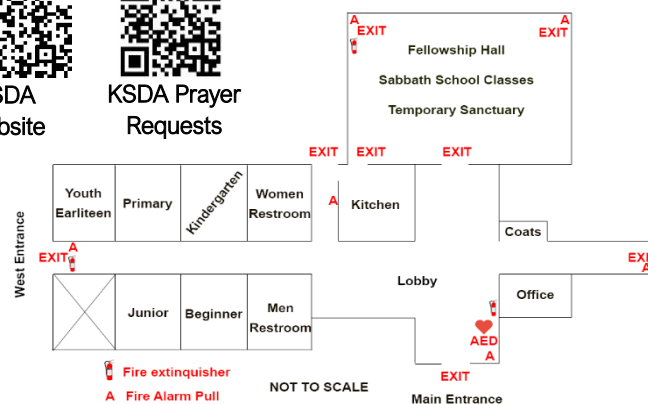
