These presentations were followed by a lot of questions and answers plus a great deal of general discussion. For the project to continue, there needed to be a 66% majority vote and the final vote was at 88% for continuing the project with the 40'X60' building for an estimated cost of \$500,000. The building committee will now begin more specific work focusing on this choice of building size and will be bringing presentations to the congregation at appropriate intervals. 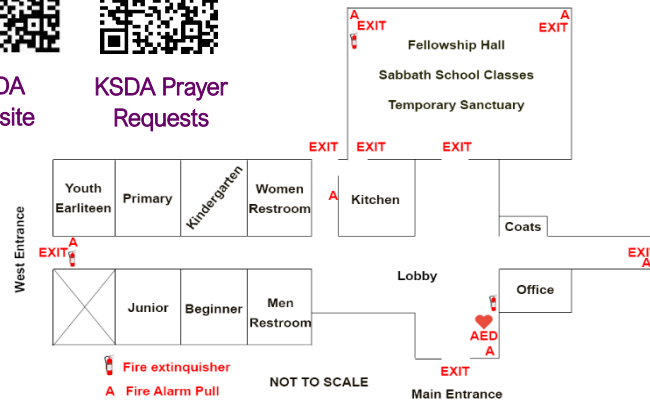
